This privacy policy outlines how Journey Bible Church uses and protects any information that you give Journey Bible when you use the church website and/or mobile app.

Journey Bible is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using the website or app, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement. Journey Bible may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are up to date with any changes.

This policy is effective starting August 1, 2023.

What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- Personally identifiable information that you provide to the church
- Browser software and versions
- Operating system

What we do with gathered information

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, particularly for the following reasons:

- To fulfill your requests for ministry programs or services
- To assist us in serving you related to a ministry in which you or your family/child participates
- To organize volunteers for ministry purposes
- To contact you when necessary
- To view and analyze site usage and operations
- To identify and address problems within our website or app, ministry or services
- To provide you with personalized messaging within the website or app

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. To prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have put in place physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. Any data collected on the website or app is stored in a secure database. Access to the data is restricted by password protection for authorized staff. Donations and online payments are encrypted and secured by our merchant provider, Planning Center/Church Center.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. The file is added and the cookie helps analyze web traffic or lets you know when you visit a



particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences. We use cookies and/or sessions to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyze data about web page traffic and improve our website to tailor it to our congregation's needs.

A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us. You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Links to other websites

Our website may contain links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over other websites. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide while visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement.
